About College:

Smt. P. K. Kotecha Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Bhusawal run by Shri Saraswati Vidya Prasark Mandal, Bhusawal is devoted to its vision: **“Enrichment of Women through Quality Higher Education for Better Society and Stronger Nation”** since 1984. It is a premier women’s college in the BhusawalTahasil.

The college is affiliated to KaviyatriBahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and is accredited with B Grade (CGPA 2.19) in the 4thCycle. It has good infrastructural facilities and support services. It offers wide range of UG and PG programmes in Arts, Commerce and Science wings. Various career oriented add-on courses are also offered keeping in view employment opportunities to the learners. Management, teachers, students and stakeholders take joint efforts to enhance and sustain quality in higher education. As a result, our students are upgraded for achievements in academic, cultural, sports and extension activities at large.

The college offers 12 UG Programmes and 05 PG programmes in the faculties of Arts, Commerce and Science. During the third cycle, the college has introduced new programmes as per demand of the stakeholders such as BCA, M.Sc. (Organic Chemistry), B.Sc. (Physics) and B.Sc. (Botany). The college also provides additional input to the students by way of wide array of short term certificate courses like Communicative English, Women Entrepreneurship, Human Rights, Basic Beauty Parlor, Dress Making, Nursery Development and GST.

09 faculty members having Ph.D as highest qualifications. **06** members are recognized as research guides and **04** students have registered for Ph.D.. The teachers have published **09** research papers and **01**chapter in edited book. **10** Faculty members were participated and **05** were presented their papers in Seminars/Conferences/ Workshops .**07** Teachers were participated in Faculty Development Programmes.The college has organized **02** Seminars/Conferences/ Workshops during the year.The college has established **4** MoUs for P.G students under NEP-2020 curriculum. Placement cell organized online Interview techniques for final year students in collaboration with ICICI Bank.

Extension activities are organized through NSS, Yuvati Sabha, and Students Development Committee etc. Activities such as tree plantation, cleanliness campaign, AatamNirbhar Yuvati Abhiyan etc. are arranged by the college. These activities create awareness about health and social issues among the students. These help to improve communication skills reveal importance of team work and indirectly contribute to students’ growth as a socially sensitive human being.

Library is fully automated through Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)

designed by Master Software, Nagpur since 2020-21 by cloud base support. The version of the software is LIB-MAN 2.1.0. Library comprises modules such as Masters, Book Management, Barcode Facility, Book Accession, Membership, Circulation, OPAC, Catalogues, and Administration, etc. The library committee organized Book Review Competition every year.

A suitable infrastructure is developed on the campus of 2.5 acres and built-up area 4628.56sq.mts. There are in all 23 well ventilated class rooms, 13 well equipped laboratories, cultural hall, seminar hall, 3 ICT class rooms and One Smart Class Room. There is a hostel which provides all the necessary facilities with an accommodating capacity of 80 students. All other support facilities such as play ground, gymkhana, gymnasium, cultural hall, seminar hall, canteen, vehicle parking, consumer store, guest room, Tiffin Park etc. are available for curricular, co-curricular, extracurricular and administrative activities.

Alumni, being the educational ambassador of the college are kept in touch with the institution through alumni meet. The institution invites the alumni members to come and deliver lectures. They also participate in annual gathering and sports tournaments occasionally.
